

# Enrolment Agreement

All students enrolling at James Sheahan Catholic High School should be aware of the following agreement.

**All students at the school re-enrolling or commencing at James Sheahan Catholic High School are to clearly understand and accept the following:**

In accepting enrolment status at James Sheahan:

- 1.1 I will endeavour to support the beliefs and attitudes promoted by the School.
- 1.2 I undertake:
  - (i) to make an honest and sustained effort to achieve my personal best in all my courses of study.
  - (ii) to act at all times with respect towards School staff and other students; and
  - (iii) to comply with all School policies and regulations.
- 1.3 I undertake also to refrain from the following forms of behaviour, seriously prejudicial to the achievement of the educational aims of the School:
  - (i) Disruption of lessons through inappropriate behaviour.
  - (ii) Unauthorised absence from class or school.
  - (iii) Consistent lack of punctuality in relation to the commencement of the school day or of a particular class.
- 1.4 I will endeavour:
  - (i) to complete assignments by the due date.
  - (ii) to return library books from the School set by the due date.
  - (iii) to return sporting equipment by the due date.
  - (iv) to wear the full School uniform as prescribed.
- 1.5 I will endeavour:
  - (i) to attend training sessions and to represent the School in accordance with School sports policy.
  - (ii) to attend practice sessions/rehearsals where I have made a commitment.
- 1.6 I undertake also to refrain from the following forms of morally/socially unacceptable behaviour:
  - (i) The possession or use of illicit drugs, alcohol or tobacco while on school grounds or off school grounds in School uniform or while attending a School function.
  - (ii) Vandalism of
    - (a) School property, such as defacing desks or walls.
    - (b) Public property.
  - (iii) Theft of
    - (a) School property, such as library books.
    - (b) Student property, such as money, books or items from students' lockers, and
    - (c) Property from shops, etc.
  - (iv) Bullying, teasing or intimidating other students physically, verbally or electronically on or off school grounds.
  - (v) Offensive language or behaviour on school grounds or public transport or any place while in School uniform
  - (vi) Bringing into the School offensive literature or photographs.
- 1.7 I undertake to accept all school regulations for Internet usage as per the Internet usage policy in the school diary.
