

## Homework Policy

Aim: to reinforce, consolidate upon or extend (where appropriate) class work in a quiet, self-directed environment, and to assist in the development of home study and organisational skills. Students are expected to devote some time at home to:

- Completing tasks begun in class
- Completing worksheets/homework sheets
- Reading
- Personal study and exam preparation
- Revision
- Completion of assignments or Assessment Tasks

While there is a definite expectation that set homework be completed by the student, and followed up by the teacher, the actual amount of time required for both set homework and personal study will clearly vary with a number of factors such as:

- The amount of work set
- The time of year
- Proximity to formal examinations
- The student's ability
- The choice or level of subject being studied

Individual subjects may have homework requirements in addition to these listed above.

Records of homework completion will be kept for review at parent/teacher interviews and/or used for report data and comments. There may be communication between teachers and parents through the school diary.
